Spring/Summer Semester: **15<sup>th</sup> of October**

## APPLICATION:

Fall/Winter Semester or Annual: **15<sup>th</sup> of July**  
Spring/Summer Semester: : **15<sup>th</sup> of November**

The application deadlines are not mandatory, but it is strongly recommended to meet them, as the Learning Agreements need to be approved before the summer holidays (usually in August).

## STEP BY STEP

After receiving the nomination email with the students' information, they will receive a message from us to:

1. **register on the University of Pisa's [ALICE portal](#);**
2. **to complete the Application Form on the [Erasmus Mobility portal](#)** (using ALICE credentials) and upload the Learning Agreement in PDF, duly signed by the student and by the Coordinator of the Sending Institution (or submit it via OLA/EWP). If you submit it via OLA/EWP, the document will be validated automatically, so you do not need to upload the signed PDF to the Erasmus Mobility portal;
3. **after the Learning Agreement is approved** (either as a PDF on the Erasmus Mobility portal or via OLA/EWP), the student will be officially registered at the University of Pisa and will receive a **student ID number** along with access to the pages dedicated to student services. **Keep in mind:** *the courses from the University of Pisa in your Learning Agreement must show both the course code and the credits.*

Detailed instructions for registering and accessing the Erasmus portal will be sent directly to students by email.

## TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS, CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE and GRADING SYSTEM

Once the student has completed all exams and verified that they have been officially registered, the **Certificate of Attendance should be sent** to the International Relations Office of the department ([rapp.int@jus.unipi.it](mailto:rapp.int@jus.unipi.it)), which will prepare the Transcript of Records. Both documents will be issued only in electronic format and sent to the home university's International Relations Office, with a copy sent to the student.

## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION and LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

Most of our courses are taught in Italian.

**An Italian language certificate is not mandatory, but a B1 in ITALIAN level is highly recommended.**

Some courses are taught in English.

For the English-taught courses that are part of the Master's degree, a **B1 level English certificate is required.**

**The University of Pisa offers a free Italian language course to all Incoming Erasmus students.**

[The University Language Centre \(CLI\)](#) → Erasmus – Italian Course for Foreigners (Erasmus Incoming) webpage should be accessed, and the instructions followed to complete the placement test.

After completing the test, each student will be assigned to a language course according to their competence level (from A1 to B2).

If the final exam is also taken, a certificate (4 ECTS credits) and a grade can be obtained.

The course is not compulsory and is completely free. Since all exams are oral and conducted in Italian, attendance is strongly recommended.
