INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PISA

AND THE FACULTY OF LAW OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HUNAN

The department of law of the Pisa University in Italy (Party A) and the faculty of law of Hunan University in China (Party B) have reached the following agreement:

ARTICLE 1 (Objectives)

The objectives of this Agreement are to promote activities that mutually enhance a better understanding of the legal systems of both countries. To this end, the following joint activities will be encouraged:

- a) exchange of visits by scholars and exchange of students;*
- b) participation in research program;*
- c) organization of periodic meetings, seminars and courses on subject laid down in the agreement;*
- d) exchange of scientific information and scientific papers.*

ARTICLE 2 (Legal Fields of Mutual Interest)

The legal fields of mutual interest are those indicated below:

- a) Roman Law and foundations of European law, History and Philosophy of Law;*
- b) Italian and Chinese Law at all Law fields.*

Such cooperation shall be carried out on the basis of equal and mutual advantage, reserving the opportunity to define, through mutual consent, further fields of activity.

ARTICLE 3 (Specific Projects)

Proposals for joint activities and their respective work plans must be the subject of specific projects, approved by the two signing institutions, and integrated and subordinate to this agreement. These projects should contain, as applicable, the necessary provisions for the implementation of its objectives.

-ARTICLE 4 (Costs and Expenses)

The funding of the proposed activities will be considered on a case-by-case basis for each specific project referred to in Article 3, which should indicate the source of funding and will depend on the availability of funds from each signing Department or University and from this agreement.

ARTICLE 5 (Entry into Force)

This agreement is subject to the approval of the competent authorities, according to the national laws of each University, and will come into force when the signatures by the Director of the Department of Law at the University of Pisa and the Dean of the Faculty of Law at the University of Hunan are affixed.

ARTICLE 6 (Duration and Execution)

For the purpose of coordinating the activities necessary for the implementation of this Agreement, the Department of Law at the University of Pisa appoints Professor Federico Procchi as its representative, and the Faculty of Law at the University of Hunan appoints Prof.ssa SONG Xiaoqing

This Agreement has a duration of five years and will be renewed for the same duration unless terminated within 6 months before its expiration.

The parties may amicably resolve any dispute that may arise from the interpretation of this agreement.

Drawn up in two original copies in English language, both having the same legal validity.
